#### It's a Wonderful Life Festival Parade Float Contest Rules

### **Eligibility**

- Open to community organizations, businesses, schools, clubs, and individuals.
- All floats must complete and submit a parade entry form by 11/30/25.

#### Float Theme

• Floats should creatively reflect the *It's a Wonderful Life* theme and maintain a respectful, family-friendly presentation suitable for all audiences. Entries containing offensive, discriminatory, or political content will not be permitted.

# **Safety Requirements**

- All floats must be constructed safely and securely.
- Riders must remain seated or standing behind railings while the float is in motion.
- No open flames, fireworks, or pyrotechnics allowed.
- Drivers must hold a valid driver's license and operate vehicles safely at all times.

#### Size and Vehicle Limits

- Floats should not exceed 40 feet in length and 12 feet in height.
- Each entry must provide its own tow vehicle, properly insured and inspected.

#### Music and Sound

- Music and sound effects are encouraged but must be family-appropriate.
- Volume should be kept at a reasonable level to allow communication between parade officials and participants.

### **Line-Up and Timing**

 Participants must check in at the designated staging area by the time specified in their confirmation email.

# **Judging Criteria**

Entries will be judged based on Creativity, Originality, Overall Appearance and Design. Judging will take place prior to the parade during the week of December 8<sup>th</sup>. We will coordinate with you on time of judging. The winner will be announced prior to the parade.

#### Awards

\$100 prize will be awarded to the winning entry. Winners will be announced during the parade and posted on the festival's website and social media.

## **Conduct & Clean-Up**

- Participants must maintain appropriate behavior throughout the parade.
- No throwing candy or items directly from vehicles walkers may distribute items safely along the route.
- All floats must be removed from the staging and disbanding areas promptly after the parade.
